These have their own parliament, president and autonomous government.

The autonomous communities are divided into provinces. Each province is divided into municipalities. Each province has a provincial government.

Except the autonomous communities made up of only one province. Islands are governed by an Island Council.

- Constitution. The Constitution establishes the forms of government and basic institutions and it defines the rights and duties of citizens. All laws must follow the Constitution.
 - Deputy. A deputy is a member of the Congress of deputies.
 - Senator. A senator is a member of the Senate.
- Monarchy. A monarchy is a form of government led by a king or a queen who is the Head of State. The position of king or queen is hereditary.

- Why do we call Spain a parliamentary monarchy? Because the Head of State is the king.

A democracy is a form of government where all the citizens have equal rights and duties.

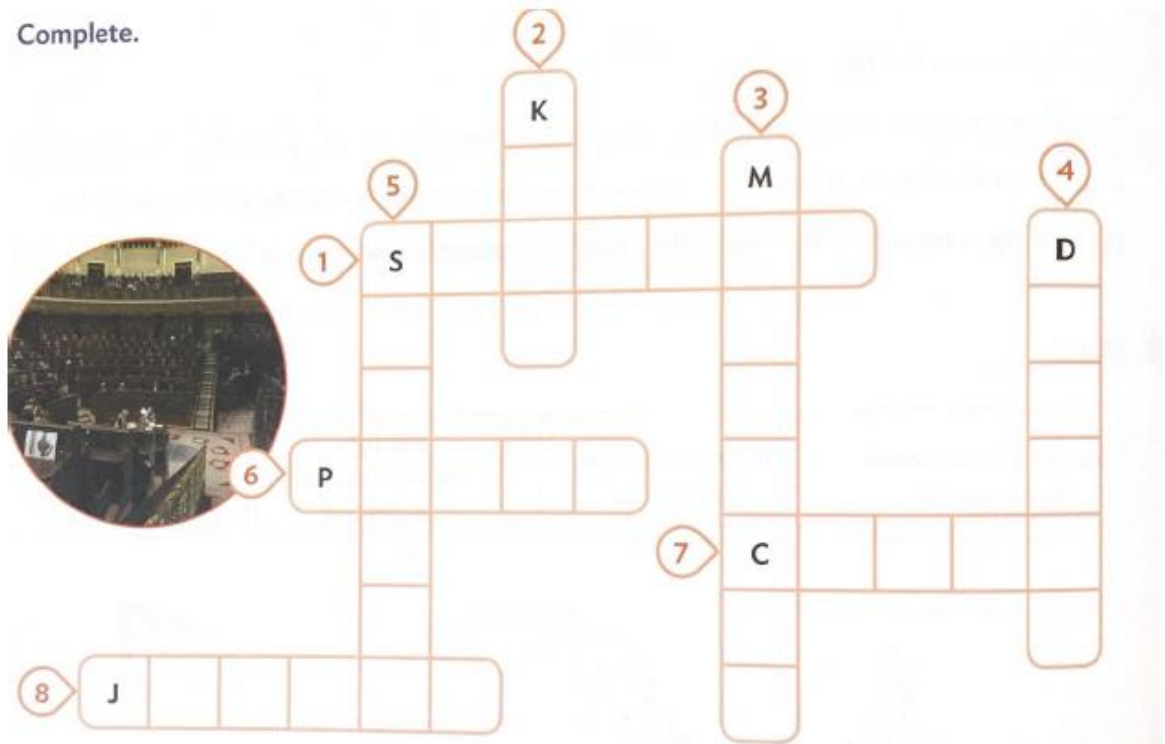
