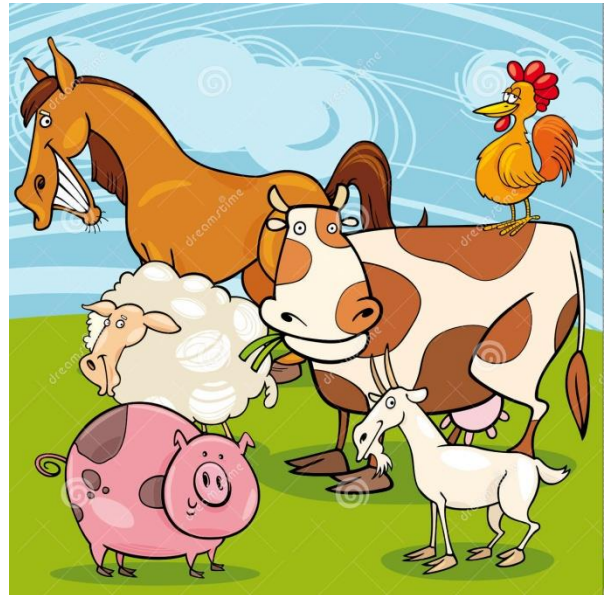


THERE IS / THERE ARE
