- **WHERE= DONDE.** Se refiere a **lugares**.

- **WHICH=QUE.** Se refiere a **cosas y animales**















This is the clue **which** we found on the balcony.(Esta es la pista **que** encontramos en la terraza)

- **WHO= QUIÉN/ QUIENES/ QUE/LOS CUALES.** Se refiere a **personas**



 WHO		<p>It is used to refer to people</p> <p>Example: The man who works at the Post Office is very kind.</p>	 
 WHICH		<p>It is used to refer to animals and objects</p> <p>Example: Tina has a bunch of flowers which his friend bought.</p>	
WHOSE		<p>It is used to refer to possession</p> <p>Example: Whose is that dictionary? Have you seen the girl whose father ...</p>	
THAT		<p>It is used to refer to people, animals, It can replace WHO or WHICH</p> <p>Example: The blue jacket that she is putting on belongs to her friend.</p>	
WHERE		<p>It used to refer to places</p> <p>The hotel where we slept was excellent</p>	
WHEN		<p>It is used to refer to time</p> <p>That was the day when my sister was born</p>
