Four of our five senses tell us the most about our food. These are sight, smell, touch and taste. But our sense of smell is the most important because our tongue can only taste four different tastes, but our nose can smell over one <sup>1</sup> *trillion* different <sup>2</sup> *smells*!

But what does our tongue tell us? Different parts of our tongue detect each of the four tastes. Our tongue can taste <sup>3</sup> *sweet* tastes like cake, <sup>4</sup> *salty* tastes like chips, <sup>5</sup> *bitter* tastes like coffee and <sup>6</sup> *sour* tastes like lemons.
