He has to train a long way away because there isn't anywhere closer. Football helps him to not get involved in crime. He wants to help his family buy a house outside the slum.

- Hollie loves dancing. After the explosion she continues to dance with her troupe. None of them are disabled but they introduced wheelchairs into routines to make her feel included. They performed Britain's Got Talent. Her hope for the future is to carry on and to be dancing the way she was.

- John Michael says that Dr. Aafia rescued him from jail. Now John has a new life, education and freedom. He helps to rescue other kids like him. In the future he wants to be a lawyer so he can defend the rights of the abused children.
